The ISES Europe Chapter advances exposure science and is an independent platform for information, identification of current/future scientific and policy needs in Europe.

ISES Europe is building a European Exposure Science Strategy with a roadmap 2020-2030. The main priorities have been set with six thematic areas:

- Data Repositories & Analytics
- Regulatory Exposure Assessment Science
- Building Partnerships & Collaboration
- Exposure Data Production & Monitoring
- Exposure Assessment Methods & Tools
- Exposure Science Education, Training & Communication

With a stakeholder-oriented and cross-working group effort, a long-term strategy for exposure science in Europe has been developed which is fully described in the published papers.
